

Petition Background and Instructions

What happened to prompt this initiative?

The Austin City Council recently approved new ridesharing rules that will soon force services like Uber and Lyft to leave town.

What are the issues with these new rules?

- Implement duplicative steps and unnecessary costs for Austinites to become drivers
- 2. Fail to recognize the inherent safety features of ridesharing apps (e.g. GPS tracking, cashless transactions, driver/rider feedback system, etc.)
- 3. Will force ridesharing to leave town, which we believe will result in fewer transportation options, less safety, and more DWIs

What am I signing?

This petition requires the City Council to either keep the common sense rules that have allowed ridesharing to thrive in Austin, or allow voters to decide in an upcoming election.

What can I do?

We need 20,000 signatures from Austin registered voters in a very short period of time! If you're registered to vote in Austin, sign the petition to voice your support for keeping ridesharing in Austin. You can also collect signatures from as many registered passengers, friends, family members, and coworkers as possible.

How to help

- 1. Fill out your information at the bottom of EACH petition page where it says 'Statement of Circulator' (Travis County, today's date, your printed name, and your signature)
- 2. Ask passengers, friends, family members, and coworkers to also sign the petition; valid signers must be registered to vote in Austin and provide date, first and last name, signature, address, and date of birth (see example below)
- 3. See the latest locations and times to drop off signed petitions under "More Information" at RidesharingWorks.com.
